9:30AM WORSHIP SERVICE ~ LIFE AGAINST DARKNESS: A STUDY OF EPHESIANS

Life often feels like it is caving in. Government and the economy, education and health care, churches and non-profits are in crisis. Our closest relationships can feel uncertain. So does our emotional health. Is there any way to save our lives from this darkness?

This is an old question. Paul gives answers in his 1st century letter to the Ephesian Christians, a letter that defies simplistic formulas for spirituality. What is the darkness that oppresses us? How does Jesus overcome it? What is our role in the world Jesus is making? Ephesians teaches a new life in Christ that darkness cannot overwhelm.
